Each client meets with a case manager to develop an individualized plan that includes referrals to housing, health, and employment resources.

LOH carries out their mission through building village schools and literacy programs, Bible translation into local dialects, and the vision of establishing a Christian college to train teachers and nurses. Child Advocates mobilizes court-appointed volunteers to break the vicious cycle of child abuse. Its volunteers speak up for abused children in Harris County who are lost in the system, and guide them into safe environments where the children can thrive.

They meet weekly at MDPC for yoga, ceramics, speakers, and lunch. The needs of mentally and physically disabled adults in Houston far exceed the available resources. *eastersealshouston.org*

MDPC Field Partners Rev. Dave and Rev. Kim equip high-level Kingdom leaders to multiply movements of the gospel and mobilize the church for mission in less reached and less resourced parts of the world (particularly in Asia). Through their strategic mentoring, training, and coaching, they help missionaries and national leaders develop their personal and professional capacities to serve God, and to intentionally multiply themselves by developing more leaders to do the same.

SUNDAY, APRIL 12

ECHOS

Epiphany Community Health Outreach Services, or ECHOS, an outreach of Episcopal Church of the Epiphany, is a faith-based organization serving the vulnerable and at-risk. It educates and provides support for them to gain access to healthcare, education, and job training. Collaborating with providers, ECHOS offers health screenings, a food pantry, ESL classes, and more for families in their community.


