Agape Development is a community development ministry grounded in the redemptive work of Jesus Christ, in the OST/South Union neighborhood. Using various programs for neighborhood children, youth, and families, Agape's mission is to address the specific brokenness of the community and transform their neighborhood by preparing Christ-following, independent community leaders.

Students are ingrained with a love for serving and for teaching their communities to reach out in service to their neighbors. Each year, graduates are sent into remote parts of Mexico where they lead churches and teach the sacrificial love of Christ through the way they live.

Archway Academy

Archway Academy is a nonprofit independent school that provides a sober learning environment for high school students who are recovering from substance use disorders and mental health issues. Students are able to continue their education in an environment that encourages their recovery process and promotes spiritual growth.

Started in 1986 by a parent at T.H. Rogers School, Be An Angel improves the quality of life for children living with multiple disabilities or profound deafness. It provides adaptive equipment (such as hearing aids), school programs, and specialized services.

Boys and Girls Country

Boys and Girls Country helps children of families in crisis by loving and nurturing them in a Christian environment, helping them grow up to become self-sustaining and contributing adults. Trained “Teaching Parents” (evidence-based Teaching Family model) live in the 11 cottages with 8 children in each. They care for the children and serve as role models, providing encouragement, accountability, and support 24 hours a day, every day of the year.

Bridges To Life (BTL) is a faith-based restorative justice program for incarcerated men and women that provides a platform for life-changing transformation. Starting in one prison in Richmond, Texas, with 41 inmate graduates in 1999, the BTL program has graduated over 53,000 men and women in 169 prisons and alternative facilities.

They meet weekly at MDPC for yoga, ceramics, speakers, and lunch. The needs of mentally and physically disabled adults in Houston far exceed the available resources.

GUM offers individual support and stability to its neighbors and teaches local children and youth life skills through Youth Ministry.

Gracewood

Gracewood is a transitional housing and family care program for single mothers in crisis and their children. It exists to strengthen families at risk for homelessness, keep families intact, and, through education, help them become independent.

Hope for Youth builds and maintains long-term Christian mentoring relationships with at-risk urban youth, primarily those whose families are staying at Star of Hope shelter. It organizes weekend outreach activities and ongoing development programs. A popular event is Friday Night Live, with games, dinner, and a pastor-led Gospel lesson.

Houston Food Bank

In 2020, HFB made possible 159 million nutritious meals through 1,500 community partners including food pantries, schools, soup kitchens, and multi-service centers. It provided 8 million meals to kids and teens through programs that address childhood hunger. MDPC is closely connected with HFB as one of our strong strategic partnerships through East Spring Branch Food Pantry, Kids' Meals, ECHOS, Fuente Food Pantry, SBISD's Backpack Buddy program, and the Food for Change program that produced the Eagle Pantry at Houston Community College Spring Branch campus.

The program is the primary, and sometimes only, referral source for other social service agencies, hospitals, and clinics that serve children younger than one year old.

Kim equip high-level Kingdom leaders to multiply movements of the gospel and mobilize the church for mission in less reached and less resourced parts of the world (particularly in Asia). Through their strategic mentoring, training, and coaching, they help missionaries and national leaders develop their personal and professional capacities to serve God, and to intentionally multiply themselves by developing more leaders to do the same.

Missionary Partner: Kristin Huffman

MDPC Field Partner Rev. Kristin Huffman serves with Frontier Fellowship, engaging in ministry to reach the unreached. She is working to mobilize churches in San Antonio and Houston (and anywhere else she is called to go), helping people begin to care about the unreached and plan ways to reach them. She is investigating a possible partnership with Mongolia, particularly with training people to reach out to the unreached in nearby countries. Kristin continues to have a passion for teaching others to engage in mission nearby and far away.
