11.	Isolation	You are my hiding place; you will protect me from trouble and surround me with songs of deliverance. Psalm 32:7
12.	Moral purity	For it is God's will that you be sanctified: that you should avoid sexual immorality; that each of you should learn to control his own body in a way that is holy and honorable, not in passionate lust like the heathen, who do not know God; and that in this matter no one should wrong his brother or take advantage of him. The Lord will punish men for all such sins, as we have already told you and warned you. 1 Thessalonians 4:3-7
13.	Financial independence	Lazy hands make a man poor, but diligent hands bring wealth. Proverbs 10:4

19.	Walking away	My brothers, if one of you should wander from the truth and someone should bring him back, remember this: Whoever turns a sinner from the error of his way will save him from death and cover over a multitude of sins. James 5:19-20
20.	Self-worth	Your beauty should not come from outward adornment, such as braided hair and the wearing of gold jewelry and fine clothes. Instead, it should be that of your inner self, the unfading beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is of great worth in God's sight. 1 Peter 3:3-4
21.	Laughter	A cheerful look brings joy to the heart, and good news gives health to the bones. Proverbs 15:30
