Ministry Area: Young Adults

Job Summary: The Young Adult Ministries Director provides the primary leadership for MDPC's ministries to young adults, along with resourcing MDPC's efforts to transfer leadership effectively to younger generations. Working collaboratively with other MDPC staff, the Director will provide vision, leadership, support, oversight, and encouragement to young adults, and seek to (1) encourage and cultivate an authentic relationship with Jesus Christ and a Christian Worldview, (2) grow the young adult population at MDPC and assist them in becoming meaningfully committed to the church, and (3) cultivate an intergenerational culture of leadership/generational transfer for MDPC's future.

Essential Duties: The Director will provide spiritual development and pastoral care for young adults, and seek to integrate the group into all aspects of MDPC's ministries; provide vision and work direction for volunteers in MDPC's young adult ministries; work with the area elder and current or future staff to develop a core group of young adults who encourage Christian faith development and a missional mindset.

Qualifications, Skills The person in this position will require the minimum of a Bachelor's degree, with a Master's degree preferred. Post-graduate studies related to Christian ministry and a minimum of three years' experience in young adult ministry in a large, multi-staff church will be a plus to succeed in this position. Proven ability to develop and administer a successful ministry program with a focus on leadership transfer.
