Job Summary: The person in this position provides primary leadership for MDPC's ministries to youth and their families. Working collaboratively with other MDPC staff, the Director will provide vision, leadership, support, oversight, and encouragement to the Youth Ministries staff, volunteers, youth, and parents.

Essential Duties:

- Works directly with Youth Ministries volunteer leaders for all programming, including Sunday mornings, retreats, mission trips, etc;
- Provides leadership for every aspect of volunteer ministry in the Youth area from communication with the volunteers through implementation of their roles in programming;
- In consultation with the Youth staff, prepares and manages the Youth portion of the MDPC annual budget;
- Provides vision and direction for MDPC's Youth ministries, which support MDPC's overall vision and ministry priorities;
- Supervises and coordinates the ministries of four direct reports, plus an Administrative Coordinator; cultivates a collaborative, harmonious, and joyful environment among the Youth team, which includes coaching, advising, encouraging, redirecting, and praying;
- Develops effective ministries for youth and their parents, which encourage Christian faith development, biblical competency, a Christian world-view, and a missional mindset.

Qualifications, Skills Must possess a minimum of a Bachelor's degree, and post-graduate studies related to Christian ministry would be a plus for success in this role; a minimum of three years' experience in youth ministry in a large, multi-staff church; and the ability to develop and administer a successful youth ministry.
